

4451 — HEBREW CALENDAR, THE

In scripture (until the captivity at least) dates are often fixed by reference to the Seasons, and to Agriculture, because the Hebrew year was divided according to natural phenomena exclusively. It combined therefore the solar and lunar year. The months began with the New Moon, but the first month was fixed (after the Exodus and by the necessities of the Passover) by the ripening of the first corn (barley). Watchmen announced to the priests at Jerusalem the first appearance of the new moon (Jer 31:6) which, being duly attested, was proclaimed by a blast of trumpets, and beacon of fires, (NB Three years, from two at least of the northern, central and southern districts of Palestine; were required for the determination of Passover month). The lunar month averaging 29.5 days, a year of 12 months of 30 and 29 days alternately naturally resulted; but this involved a variation of 11 and 22 days alternately in 18 of 19 years. To reconcile this lunar year with the year of seasons, **a 13th month must be inserted about once in three years**. This the Jews probably intercalated before the first month, i.e in what would seem a backward season, for they now **call it Veadar, or the 2nd Adar, but it is not mentioned in the Bible**. Thus their practice approximated roughly to the Metonic cycle (adopted by the modern Jews about A.D 360), in which a year of 13 months is inserted in seven (intercalary) out of a cycle of 19 years. In the subjoined Calendar,, it is assumed, as usual , that the first month of the Hebrew ecclesiastical year, **Abib or Nisan, answers to half March and half April; the earliest possible commencement of the lunar year being on our March 5th.**

IS IT NOT WRITTEN?

As I was reading the excerpt from the Thompsons KJV Bible version on page 1800 which I have shared severally on various media, a certain statement forced me to write this document. It's their statement concerning the 13th month in the Bible. *This bible version says in its entry number 4451 about the Hebrew Calendar, that the month VeAdar is not mentioned anywhere in the Bible.*

In this study today I want to demonstrate the existence of a 13th month in the bible and go further to show how we came to have a 13th month.

Before we go to the verses, let me draw your attention to the tabulations on page 1. Every calendar has a way in which it operates. Some formulae on how the calendar gets where it says. The bible calendar has been discovered to have its formula as well. While the months of a Gregorian calendar play between 30 and 31 days year in year out, and sometimes having 29 days in February, regardless of the moons cycle. The calendar of the bible was discovered to have a 19 year cycle named the Metonic Cycle after the man who made the discovery. In the first long table is a display of the 19 year cycle for this period which started with the new moon of April 4th 2011 and will reach its climax at the end of the last month in the nineteenth year on April 2nd 2030. In the current cycle, by the time of writing of this document, we are in Year 9 the 8th month which started on Oct, 29th 2019.

By understanding this 19 year cycle, the bible calendar can be overlaid on any other calendar to know when Gods Sabbath aligns with that calendar as has been done with the Gregorian calendar. Meton found out that after every 235 lunations, the Earth, Sun and Moon go back to a straight line alignment for a new set. The days of each month can also be determined from this cycle. Before the flood of Noah's time, months consisted of a constant 30 day cycle and a year of 12 months. This has ever changed since that time from the evidence of the cycles we have in the post Noah times.

(Make more studies about Metonic cycle on your own and get more of what I haven't mentioned in my summary here)

That said, lets go on to study the reality of the 13th month with several verses which I request that you shall take your time to study as I pick a few verses which are useful to this demonstration.

Study by yourself in the book of Ezekiel from chapter 1 to chapter 8. Then I will pick the following verses.

Eze 1:1-2 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth [month], in the fifth [day] of the month, as I [was] among the captives by the river of Chebar, [that] the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God.

1:2 In the fifth [day] of the month, which [was] the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity

Eze 3:13-17 [I heard] also the noise of the wings of the living creatures that touched one another, and the noise of the wheels over against them, and a noise of a great rushing.

3:14 So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me.

3:15 Then I came to them of the captivity at Telabib, that dwelt by the river of Chebar, and I sat where they sat, and remained there astonished among them seven days.

3:16 And it came to pass at the end of seven days, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

3:17 Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me.

Eze 4:4-9 Lie thou also upon thy left side, and lay the iniquity of the house of Israel upon it: [according] to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon it thou shalt bear their iniquity.

4:5 For I have laid upon thee the years of their iniquity, according to the number of the days, three hundred and ninety days: so shalt thou bear the iniquity of the house of Israel.

4:6 And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed thee each day for a year.

4:7 Therefore thou shalt set thy face toward the siege of Jerusalem, and thine arm [shall be] uncovered, and thou shalt prophesy against it.

4:8 And, behold, I will lay bands upon thee, and thou shalt not turn thee from one side to another, till thou hast ended the days of thy siege.

4:9 Take thou also unto thee wheat, and barley, and beans, and lentiles, and millet, and fitches, and put them in one vessel, and make thee bread thereof, [according] to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon thy side, three hundred and ninety days shalt thou eat thereof.

Eze 8:1 And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth [month], in the fifth [day] of the month, [as] I sat in mine house, and the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord GOD fell there upon me.

In the highlighted verses above, you find that Ezekiel was to lie on his left side for a period of 390 days then turn to his right side for another 40 days. This gives us a total of 430 days for lying on both sides. This period is said to have started in the Twelfth day of the Fourth month in the FIFTH YEAR of Jehoiachin's captivity until we find Ezekiel SITTING in his house

on the Fifth day of the Sixth month in the SIXTH YEAR of Jehoiachin’s captivity.

This period must therefore without doubt have crossed two years. Finding Ezekiel seated in his house and not lying on either side means he must have accomplished God’s command of lying on both the left and right side.

So we go the calendar part of it. We start asking ourselves which calendar gives us the correct timing whereby the command of God will fit rightly and find Ezekiel on the safe side with God. Its fair to start with the known towards the unknown and I will start counting using the common Roman Catholic Gregorian Calendar to see if it shall give us this timeframe and keep Ezekiel within God’s command by ensuring he lies on his left side and right side for at least 430 days.

On the 5th day of the fourth month, God shows Ezekiel a vision which amazes him for another 7 days. That’s date 11 of the fourth month (The month called Tammuz). On this 11th day, God appears to him again with further directions and after this day nothing more is said. So Ezekiel must have taken the instructions and started the execution. He was to bake bread which was to be eaten for 390 days. The verse doesn’t say that the bread will be sufficient for the 430 days.

So from the 11th day of the fourth month we have another 19 days to end the Gregorian month of 30 days. Then the last sixth month we add 5 days because it didn’t end. As follows given that the period would have occurred during the Gregorian leap year which has its February with 29 days.

Gregorian gives us a total of at most 421 days for this period. If Ezekiel had followed this calendar, he would have disobeyed God by not lying on either side for the allotted time. The whole period has to add up to 430 days but this calendar is less to that period by 9 or 10 days. So right away, the Gregorian calendar misses the mark as it has always done.

Lets use the Pre-Flood Luni-Solar calendar which had a constant month of 30 days and 12 month years

This calendar too misses the mark. If this is what was in use during Ezekiel's time, then he would have disobeyed God by doing less to what the command said. He would have been short by 16 days. So this is not the one.

Last but not least, allow me to demonstrate with the Bible Calendar that is in use today and one which was in use also during Ezekiel's time all through to the time of Jesus and which was nullified by the Roman Catholic through their leader the Pope Gregory XIII in a last bid to detach humanity from the way of God. It is the calendar on the long table at the beginning of this document and for the purposes of demonstration, I will pick one year with the 12 month cycle and another with a 13th month cycle also known as VeAdar. I will use the longest 12 month cycle and the shortest 13th year cycle then leave the rest of the computation to you for homework as I call it a day.

The computation in the table above combines a normal year of 12 months and one of 13 months in the current Bible calendar to unlock the mystery of the 13th month which couldn't be done by any other calendar. If the 430 days are counted from the fourth month in a common year to the sixth month dates of the following common year, the days can't add up to 430 or more. But if the count starts the fourth month of a leap year then ends in the sixth month of a common year, the 430 days are realized. Meaning that the Fifth year upon which the vision was given was a leap year with 13 months followed by a common year the Sixth year as usual, so as to get us to the fifth day of the sixth month the following year and find the order safely carried out.

Except the current Bible calendar, there is no other that has the leap year with a 13th month and which if used we can arrive accurately to the period written in the verses as shown. This outstanding feature and accuracy is only found with things of our God. Praise be to Him.

This is the greatness of our God of whom it is written in **1 Cor 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.**

This also tells us that Ezekiel had at least six days in his business after accomplishing what God ordered him to do.

WHERE DID THIS 13TH MONTH COME FROM?

This is also another important question to handle. Yet another story is taught in the bible. In the book of 2 Kings chapter 20. it's the great story of how king Hezekiah was healed and the sign of this.

We find God giving Hezekiah an option of how he wants the suns shadow to move. In other words how he wants the sun to be moved. It reads as follows;

2 Kings 20:4-11 And it came to pass, afore Isaiah was gone out into the middle court, that the word of the LORD came to him, saying, 5 Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: on the third day thou shalt go up unto the house of the LORD. 6 And I will add unto thy days fifteen years; and I will deliver thee and this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria; and I will defend this city for mine own sake, and for my servant David's sake. 7 And Isaiah said, Take a lump of figs. And they took and laid [it] on the boil, and he recovered. **8 And Hezekiah said unto Isaiah, What [shall be] the sign that the LORD will heal me, and that I shall go up into the house of the LORD the third day?** 9 And Isaiah said, **This sign shalt thou have of the LORD, That the LORD will do the thing that he hath spoken:** shall the shadow go forward ten degrees, or go back ten degrees? 10 And Hezekiah answered, It is a light thing for the shadow to go down ten degrees: nay, but let the shadow return backward ten degrees. 11 And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.

The question we need to answer here is how much time is 10 degrees and how does it affect the Moon cycles since it was only the sun that moved backwards, not the moon. In fact the moon was still moving forward.

It has been proven that one hour is equal to 15 degrees turn. If 60 minutes is equal to 15 degrees, how much is 10 degrees?

15 degrees = 60 min
10 degrees = ? Min Cross multiplication gives us 10 x 60 divided by 15 which equals to 40 min.

So the sun was turned backwards by 40 min that day. The moon gained 40 min into its cycle as well and since the moon reflects light from the sun, the position of reflection changed. Every time you see the moon shining, understand that it is shining at a point which is 40 min ahead of the sun.

This alteration has been carried into all days thereafter till this day. So for the moon and the sun to come back to that alignment where they were we have to get into another math.

40 min a day for 30 days gives us **1200 min difference per month.**
1200 min a month for 12 months a year gives us 14400 min a year
14400 min for 3 years we come to 43200 min
CONVERTING this to hours it gives 43200 divide by 60 = 720 hours
720 hours divided by 24 hours a day gives us **30 days lost in three years**

This is why after every 3 or 2 years, the bible calendar has to add an extra month called VeAdar to compensate for the cycle lost by the Hezekiah's sign.

That's the God we worship. What He does lives forever and we have the evidence of the 13th month as a sign of healing. If God had given Hezekiah the opportunity to choose how many degrees the sun was to be turned back, maybe we could be having a very disorganized time, but it having been a fixed choice gave God an opportunity to teach us a lifetime lesson.

53 And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

54 **And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.**

55 And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid.

56 **And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment**

Luke 23: 50- 55 (GOOD NEWS BIBLE) (Vs 54 is a STRANGE FABRICATION OF SCRIPTURE TODAY)

The Burial of Jesus

50-51 There was a man named Joseph from Arimathea, a town in Judea. He was a good and honorable man, who was waiting for the coming of the Kingdom of God. Although he was a member of the Council, he had not agreed with their decision and action.

52 He went into the presence of Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus.

53 Then he took the body down, wrapped it in a linen sheet, and placed it in a tomb which had been dug out

of solid rock and which had never been used.

54 It was Friday, and the Sabbath was about to begin.

55 The women who had followed Jesus from Galilee went with Joseph and saw the tomb and how Jesus' body was placed in it. Then they went back home and prepared the spices and perfumes for the body.

On the Sabbath they rested, as the Law commanded

Leviticus 23:5-8

[5]On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the Lord's Passover.

[6]On the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the Lord; for seven days you shall eat unleavened bread. [I Cor. 5:7, 8.]

[7]On the first day you shall have a holy "calling together;" you shall do no servile or laborious work on that day.

[8]But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord for seven days; on the Seventh day is a holy convocation; you shall do no servile or laborious work on that day.

John 11:55 - 56

55 And the Jews' Passover was nigh at hand: and many went out of the country up to Jerusalem before the Passover, to purify themselves.

56 Then sought they for Jesus, and spake among themselves, as they stood in the temple, What think ye, that he will not come to the feast?

Luke 6:6

6 And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.

Again I wish to point out from scriptures that the day which many have defended as Bible Sabbath and which has been recently held as so is actually a corruption of scripture and must therefore fall the moment it sneaks itself into the Bible. **You cannot mention Passover and Friday in the same statement and hide the calendar in use then expect the world to swallow both in one gulp.** Those are two days in two different calendars. Passover is always the 14th day Abib and a sixth day in Bible calendar always, but Friday belongs to the Roman Catholic Gregorian calendar and without a specific date. The day called Saturday or SATURNS DAY, is not a better devil than the SUN'S DAY SUNDAY in the Pagan calendar system.

From these verses. One conclusion is that the bible is not silent as to which day is Seventh to enable us worship according to God's command. The Sabbath is not hidden.

When Jesus came, he found the Jews still doing circumcision and He also went through it well when he was Eight days old according the scripture, (**Luke 2:21 see the difference with Luke 1:59**) these guys saw this act as so important and did it on the Sabbath also. In doing so, they decided that they shall be circumcising their males even on the Sabbath day. When Jesus found them doing so, he took his time to lecture them back to the true application and upheld the bible calendar in the verse of **John 7: 22-23**. This great verse calls us to remember the Sabbath. Jesus here says that they do circumcision on the Sabbath day and they are good with it. He doesn't have a problem with when Sabbath is supposed to be but what is done therein.

Lets get another proof of Bible Sabbath Day During the Passover time.

The Passover is identified also by date and it was on 14th day of the First month each year, not after every 3 months. This date came on a specific day. All those years. It is on Passover that humanity killed Jesus and the bible says in **John 19:31** that the day after Passover was a high Sabbath. In **Leviticus 23:6** we understand that the day after Passover was the 15th day of the 1st month and it was the FIRST DAY OF UNLEAVENED BREAD DAYS. John 19:31 says it was a high Sabbath. That's what it is, two holy days meeting in a single

day. So when the bible says that the Sabbath was about to begin, it is the weekly Sabbath and the Feast of Unleavened bread in tandem.

John 12:1 Then Jesus six days before the Passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead

Six days before the Passover of 14th, Jesus is at Lazarus' place. That day is very easy to locate as well.

Six days BEFORE date 14 of Passover brings us to date 8, 15th is the Seventh day of the Passover week. So the Bible is saying that the Sabbath before Passover, Jesus worshipped at Bethany then later had Supper with Lazarus according to verse 2. On the night of 8th, Jesus is at Lazarus place. That is the night of the Sabbath of 8th. JESUS IS THEN KILLED ON 14TH, RESTS ON THE GRAVE ON SABBATH 15TH THEN ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK, THE 16TH HE RAISES AGAIN. Now comes Cleopas and others ON THE SAME DAY on their way to Emmaus. **Luke 24:13-16** And, behold, **two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus**, which was from Jerusalem [about] threescore furlongs. 14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened. 15 And it came to pass, that, while they communed [together] and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them. 16 But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.

Early that morning of 16th, another detail is added in John 20:11-18 which you should read. This date 16, the Bible says in **Lev 23:11** And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: *on the morrow after the sabbath* the priest shall wave it. The Sabbath mentioned here is the First day of unleavened bread, the day after Passover, the day after Jesus was killed. Date 15. on 16th is the celebration of the Wave Sheaf or First Fruits which was meant to symbolise the Resurrection of the one whom the types pointed to—Jesus

If then the 15th was Sabbath day all those years, there arises no question of where Jesus was when 22nd or 15th or 29th or 8th came. It is recorded in **Luke 4:16** And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, **as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read.**

It is also recorded that JESUS was fully obedient to his Father in all things. ***Now comes the date 1. where was Jesus on this day? Heb 4:15*** For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; **but was in all points tempted like as [we are, yet] without sin.** **Mat 26:39** And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: **nevertheless not as I will, but as thou [wilt].** Talk of total obedience. All months in the Bible start with a New Moon Day. It is date 1 and its a day of worship. It is therefore logical to say that Jesus was in the temple for this service all time it came. According to **Eze 46:1, Amos 8:4-6, 2 kings 4:20-23, Isa 66:22-23, Exo 20:8-11**

Read also in the Book of John chapter 7 and 8 to see the Sabbath as taught in the bible. **John 7:2,36-37,53,8;1-3** Now the Jews' feast of tabernacles was at hand 37 **In the last day, that great [day] of the feast,** Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. 38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. **53 And every man went unto his own house.** 8: **1 Jesus went unto the mount of Olives. 2 And early in the morning he came again into the temple,** and all the people came unto him; and he sat down, and taught them. 3 And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,

Leviticus 23:24 - 25, 34-36, 39

24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a Sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

25 Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the LORD.

35 On the first day shall be an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.

36 Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein.

39 Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: on the first day shall be a Sabbath, and on the eighth day shall be a Sabbath.

From 15th for 7 days is Feast of Tabernacles. That brings us to **21st, the LAST DAY OF THE FEAST**, then on the morrow came Jesus again to the Temple, not for sideshows or merry-go-rounds but for the Sabbath day, the Eighth day in verse 36 of Leviticus 23. Again refer to the calendar dates I had shown earlier. 15th is Sabbath, 22nd is Sabbath and so is 8th and 29th. This is in the SEVENTH MONTH and the month system is the same.

Acts 17:2 - 3

8—15—22—29 is the sequence of Sabbath days in the bible. A constant sequence which makes us say that time has never been lost and it is rightly so. **Time cannot be lost, it can only be MISUNDERSTOOD, BE MISCALCULATED, BE UNACCOUNTED FOR etc, but not lost as some want us to believe.**

God made the Sun to tell days and all days are identified by the Moon as per Genesis 1:14-18. The calendar of the bible combines the Solar and the Lunar cycle to give us the correct time. What we have commonly held to as a repeating seven day cycle making the week is a total lie and misinterpretation of scriptures. God made and classified the days into three categories. We have **THE SIX WORKING DAYS, THE SABBATH DAYS AND THE NEW MOON DAY**. Therefore God gave us the marker of these days, the faithful witness in the sky, the moon as per **Psalms 89:37**.

The New Moon Day is the start of a new month and identified as date 1, then we go to the first working day on date 2 of that specific month and all other days are spoken unmistakably by the Moon phases throughout the month.

We have a duty to study what God made and how it works. The week we have known in this age is only a solar week, **lets learn the full truth of the marker in the sky which tells us all three categories of days.**

The good news bible is yet to prove if its system fits into the Bible calendar before it talks of FRIDAY as the day of Passover or SATURDAY as 15th of the month. Its one bitter reality that even in the year of crucifixion in AD 31, the Passover didn't fall on the Gregorian Friday as the myth states. It was on a Wednesday. You can look for this information to awaken yourself to its reality.

NEW MOON DAY AND SABBATH DAY ARE WORSHIP DAYS NOT COMMERCE DAYS but new moon day is not a Sabbath day. The only New Moon day which is a Sabbath day is the New Moon of the Seventh month. Working days are not Sabbath days except the Tenth day of the Seventh month. **See Lev 23:24-32**

The Seven days of Unleavened bread days on the PASSOVER WEEK in the First month are days of worship with the first day being a Sabbath day, same to the Seven days of the Feast of Tabernacles in the seventh month.

TAKE YOUR TIME TO UNLEARN THE LIE IN THE GREGORIAN CALENDAR AND GET INTO THE BIBLE SYSTEM BEFORE IT IS TOO LATE.

Dan 7:25 And he shall speak *great* words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

Woe unto man. Against this prophecy, no attempt of man can prevail.

In this verse of the bible lies all the source and solution to the great calendars controversy. God saw it coming even before man thought of it.

Various versions of explanations have been carried forward in a bid to understand this verse and I won't debate on them. Lemme give my version of the story with due respect to my predecessors.

The bible is very clear, that he shall not prevail doing any slight change to adjust the works of God. What God has done shall stand forever **(Psalms 78:69, 89:37)**

The verse now tells us that MAN SHALL ONLY THINK TO CHANGE, at best he shall only appear to have done anything. Nothing shall have been accomplished when all is said and done.

To demonstrate is much better so as to understand what man is said to be planning.

When for example a boy/girl in their adolescence get attracted to each other, there is obviously so much drama and fantasizing. You may find them bragging to their friends how much they have done to their newly found love. Bragging of how much great time they had a yester night, how much presents they have send to their loved ones and many more.

The story goes on with so much lacing that the listener almost wholly believes the version of it as the rumor spreads among his group.

But what is the reality? Nothing has happened, the targeted boy/girl is very much well and untouched. All the propaganda doing rounds is just a demonstration of diversionary tactics. Nothing has happened on the ground, Things are totally different.

The man on **Daniel 7:25** is exactly like these adolescents. HE ONLY THINKS THAT HE HAS MANAGED TO CHANGE TIME. Nothing has happened.

Then we begin another half of 12hrs darkness. Is it true to teach that 1200hrs noon is the midday hour? That's a lie, and the sun comes early in the morning to disprove that propaganda

Midday is a point where light gives way to darkness. Everything else exists only in the THOUGHTS OF MAN, it is nowhere to be proved.

So even if man should say that today is the 45th day of 23rd month in the 45,000th year, it doesn't affect God's evidence. It only exists in the thoughts of man.
